RACE NUMBER DISTRIBUTION

The race numbers for school teams and individual participants from Berlin are only distributed at the BERLIN-VITAL sports fair. School teams from outside of Berlin and individual participants from other countries can also pick up their start documents on Saturday, September 23rd, 2017 from 12 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Matthäikirchplatz.



Opening Times of mini-MARATHON Race Number Distribution:

Thursday September, 21st 2017 12:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m.

Friday September, 22nd 2017 12:00 a.m.- 8:00 p.m.

Race number distribution is located in the **SHOWROOM** of the STATION Berlin, Luckenwalder Str. 4-6, 10963 Berlin.

Public Transportation: subway U1/U2 to U-Bhf Gleisdreieck, train S1/S2/S25 to S-Bhf Anhalter Bahnhof plus 8 min walk, bus 248 to Möckernbrücke; bus M41 to Anhalter Bahnhof.

TIMEKEEPING

Timekeeping will be done using the MIKA TAG. The MIKA TAG consists of a race number on which a transponder is applied. Champion-Chip will not be used.

MIKA TAG is a single use transponder and can be retained after the race.

Important: Personally owned CHAMPION CHIPS can not be used in this race!

START

Potsdamer Straße / Sigismundstraße

Starting times: Oberschulen 3:10 p.m.

Grundschulen 3:20 p.m.

Participants who are not positioned in their respective starting blocks, will be disqualified.

CLASSIFICATION

All students

Oberschulen: YoB 1998 and younger

Grundschulen: YoB 2005 - 2008

RACE NUMBERS

Due to insurance reasons the race numbers must be worn on the chest. There is an "EMERGENCY PASSPORT" on the back of each race number. For safety and to assure prompt assistance, please fill in all the respective personal data.

BAGGAGE TRUCKS

There are trucks for clothing drop-off available for the runners at Matthäikirchplatz. No valuable items or keys are allowed to be kept in the clothing bags. The organizer is not liable for any damage or loss of personal items.

End of drop-off: 2:35 p.m.

The trucks are then leaving for the finish area where the clothing

bags must be picked up again until 5:20 p.m.

FINISH

Straße des 17. Juni, near Sowjetisches Ehrenmal

MEDALS

Every participant receives a mini-MARATHON medal.

CERTIFICATES

Every participant receives a mini-MARATHON certificate.

REFRESHMENTS

Water and fruit are provided in the finish area for all participants of the mini-MARATHON.

PARENTS MEETING AREA

The parents meeting area is located in the Straße des 17. Juni. There will be signs where the participants leave the finish area according to their respective grade and which can be used for orientation. Please do not confuse the parents meeting area for the mini-MARATHON with the family reunion area for the BERLIN-MARATHON.

AWARD CEREMONY

The fastest runners (male/female) will be honored at a short ceremony after the race on Saturday, September, 23rd. The best school teams will be honored at an award ceremony on October, 11th, 2017. There won't be an individual score.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE

First aid is available by the medical team, first aid teams and the fire department in the start/finish area as well as along the course. Our medical network will be everywhere. Please don't hesitate to contact our medical personnel if you are having difficulties or notice someone else who needs help. If you would like to phone in an emergency, please ask a spectator to immediately call the emergency number **112** (keyword: **MARATHON** and your exact position and the race number).

IMPORTANT! Please also fill out the back of the race number, especially a mobile number and contact for the case of an emergency.

START AREA

The start area is located at Matthäikirchplatz (Potsdamer Str. / Sigismundstr.). The formation of the participants into their starting blocks Oberschulen + Grundschulen takes place there. It is best reached by subway (U2) or S-Bahn (S1, S2, S25) and a short walk.

Starting times:

Oberschulen **3:10 p.m.**
 Grundschulen **3:20 p.m.**

COURSE

The **course of the mini-MARATHON** matches the last kilometres of the BMW BERLIN-MARATHON.

The **START** is on Saturday, September 23rd on the **Potsdamer Straße**. Then it continues down **Leipziger Straße**, beyond Friedrichstraße, turning left into **Jerusalemstraße**. From there the participants turn left on **Hausvogteiplatz** towards **Gendarmenmarkt**. Via Französische Straße and **Glinkastraße** they arrive at **Unter den Linden**, from where they only have to go straight to **Brandenburg Gate** and towards the **FINISH** line on Straße des 17. Juni.

finish area

The finish area of the mini-MARATHON is widely closed off. Only supervising teachers of school teams are allowed to enter the finish area on the Straße des 17. Juni with a special accreditation.

For safety reasons parents and supervising teachers of individual participants are not allowed to enter the finish area.

With about 10.000 participants we ask for your understanding that a reunion of the participants and their parents requires a certain waiting time and will not take place instantly after the race. The participants will leave the finish area through various exits according to their respective grade. The race number identification marks on the clothing trucks can also be used as a meeting point for parents and participants.

Parents are asked to not obstruct the exits, to carefully pay attention to all information and therefore help making this event successful.
